



Alban Muja (born 1980 in Mitrovica) is a Kosovo based visual artist and filmmaker. He completed his BA and MA at Faculty of Fine Arts at University of Prishtina and in Santa Fe Art Institute, New Mexico USA. . Mostly influenced by the social, political and economical transformation processes in wider surrounding region, he investigates history and socio-political themes and links them to his position in Kosovo today. His works cover a wide range of media including video installation, films, documentary film, drawings, paintings, photographs and performance which have been exhibited extensively in various film festivals, art fairs, group and solo exhibitions.
